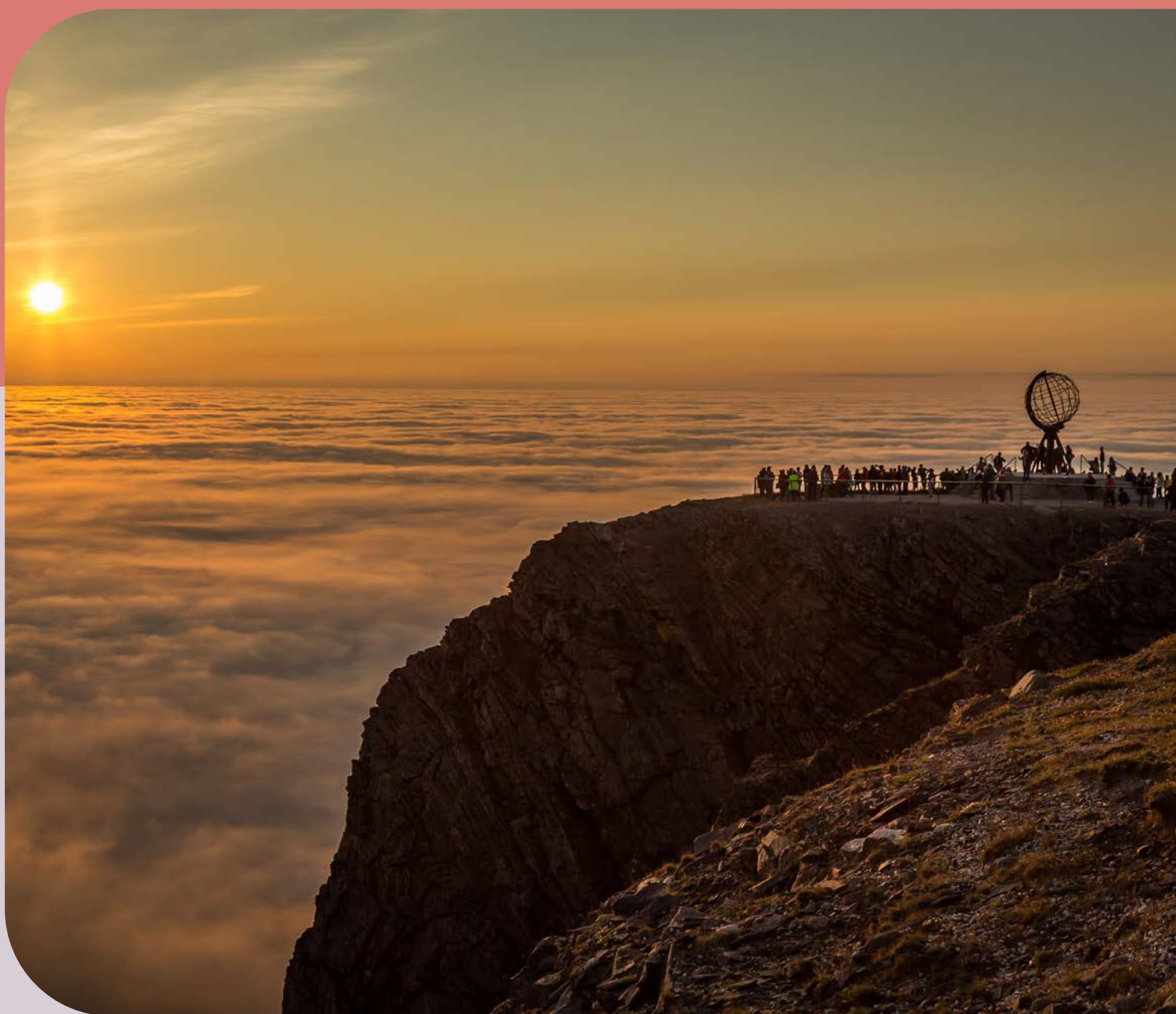

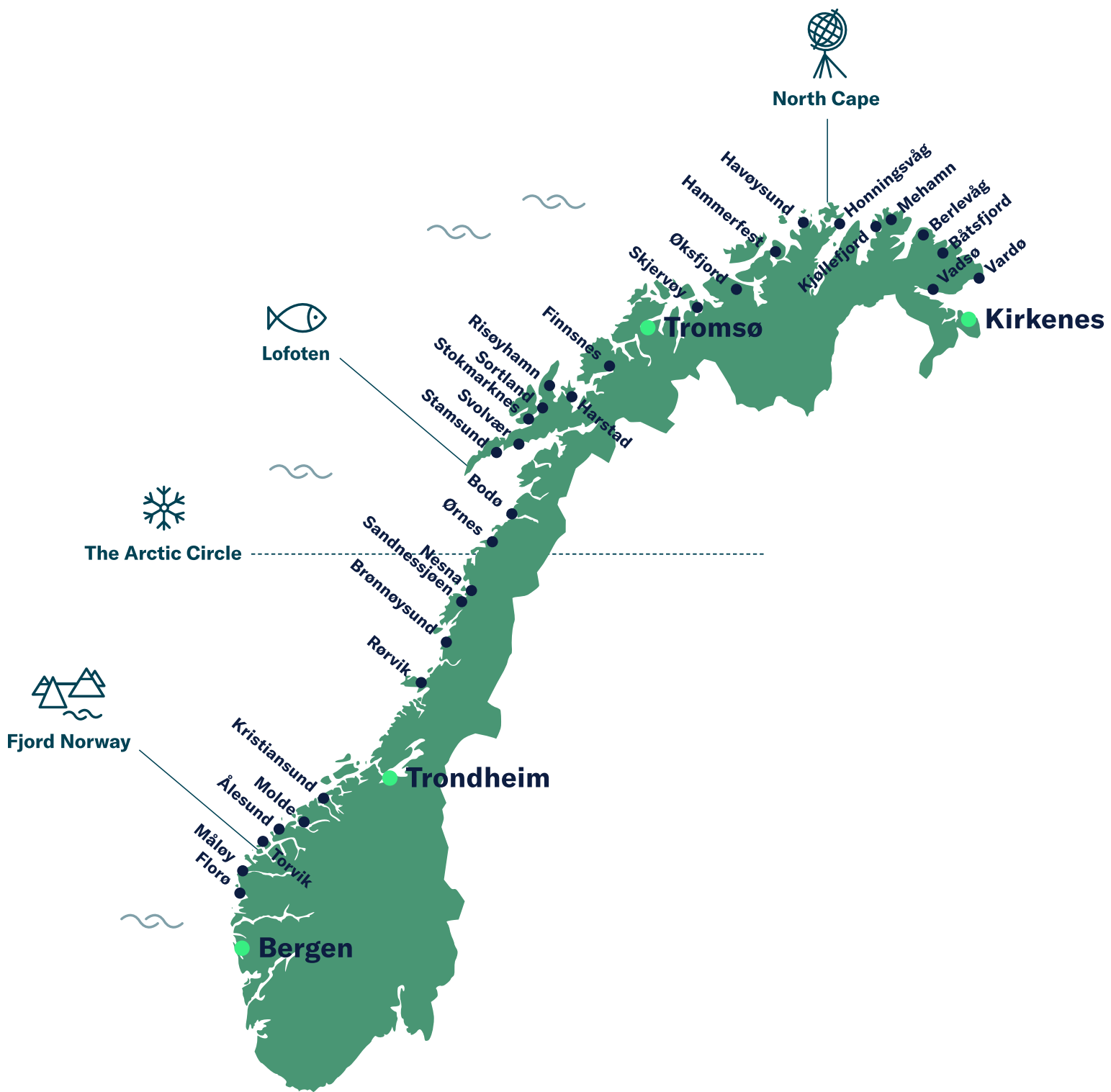




ENHANCE YOUR VOYAGE WITH COASTAL EXCURSIONS

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

SAFETY AND CANCELLATIONS

Travelling with Havila Voyages gives you the opportunity to encounter and enjoy Norwegian nature. Therefore, many of the excursions you can choose from are outdoors and often in the spectacular but untamed and rugged coastal landscape and its surrounding waters.

In addition to its beauty, the Norwegian coast is also known for having a lot of weather. You can experience four seasons in one day, and occasionally the weather can be unsuitable for the operation of excursions.

Our priority is always the safety and comfort of our guests, and if local conditions mean that we must cancel any excursion then of course the cost will be refunded.

HOLIDAY

There are also a few days a year when it is likely many excursions will not operate: Christmas Eve (24 Dec), New Year's Day (1 Jan) And Norway's National Day (17 May). Your journey and experience onboard will instead reflect these special anniversaries and in some ports, we will look to arrange alternative excursions, but they will only be available for sale onboard.

NUMBERS OF PARTICIPANTS

If there are not enough participants for an excursion to run, it may be cancelled. The minimum number of participants is stated on each excursion.

GUIDING AND LANGUAGES

Unless otherwise specified on the excursion, guides will provide information in Norwegian, English and German. Other languages on request.

LEVEL 1

Suitable for everyone*

Excursions at this level are undemanding, and you are often transported in vehicles.

LEVEL 2

Suitable for most people

Moderate physical activity that suits most people. Involves easy terrain without major challenges.

LEVEL 3

Average physical condition

Uneven and steep terrain may occur, and it may be necessary to bring equipment and similar items that you have to carry yourself. This excursion is not suitable for people with limited mobility. When driving vehicles such as snowmobiles, sleds and ATVs, you must have normal vision and hearing. A certain level of mobility and ability to react are also required.

NORWAY IN A NUTSHELL

This tour takes you through some of Norway's most iconic experiences, a beautiful train journey, the breathtaking Flåm Railway and a cruise on the UNESCO-protected Nærøysfjord.

The Flåm Railway has been described as one of the most beautiful train journeys in the world—and is also one of the steepest. You start at sea level and within an hour, you will have travelled through 20 tunnels, past many viewpoints and photo stops in the narrow valley and end up at 867 metres above sea level.

On its way to the top, the road winds its way up 13 sharp hairpin bends, while the large waterfalls come thundering straight down the shortest route. This day tour is beautiful, picturesque and encapsulates Norway.

The captain of the sailboat takes you through the lively harbor with a view of several of Bergen's most famous sights.

FISHING ADVENTURE IN ÅLESUND

Join us for winter fishing at sea! Afterwards, you will be able to eat the fresh fish on board Havila ship – prepare yourself for your best fish meal ever!

On this excursion you get to take part in fishing from the fjord – and to the table. You will board a modern fishing boat, out on the water we will pull traps and fish with fishing rods. What you get depends on the season, but it will still be your best catch of the day.. And not only do you get to catch the seafood. When you return to the quay, the skipper will fillet the catch for you, and on board the Havila ship, the chefs will help you prepare a tasty fish meal at the outside grill at Deck 7. You can enjoy your dinner outdoor on the deck or in the main restaurant.

The excursion also gives you a taste of the local fishing history. Ålesund is located in Norway's largest fishing county, Møre og Romsdal. Eight times more fish are caught and produced than Norway's population meaning that fishing is Norway's second largest export industry after oil and gas.

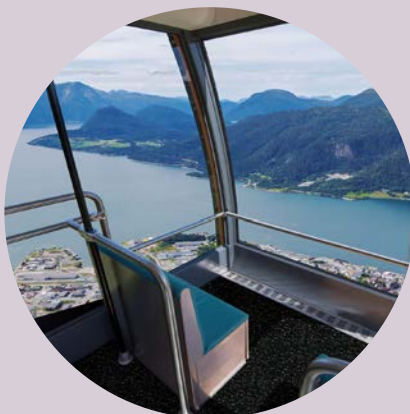

Romsdalen boasts steep, wild mountains that rise up to 1,500 m. Trollveggen, Europe's highest vertical, overhead rock face that extends to a height of 1,000 m is here, in addition to some of the world's most challenging climbing routes. The Romsdal Alps were the European birthplace of climbing and mountaineering in the late 1800s.

When you are in the visitor centre beneath the enormous Trollveggen, you might wonder how it is possible to climb such mountains. You will find this out in the film you are shown at Norsk Tindesenter. The architecture of Norsk Tindesenter is spectacular and mirrors the mountains around it. Exhibitions are held in the centre, and it also boasts the highest indoor climbing wall in Norway.

To round off the trip, take the Romsdal gondola to 700 m above sea level. You can go for a stroll there, find out more about scaling the peaks and hear stories about the mountains. Finally, there is lunch with magnificent views of the fjord and Alpine landscape.

GEIRANGER AND TROLLSTIGEN

Geirangerfjord's splendour is on the UNESCO World Heritage List and on most travellers' "must see" list in Norway. On this excursion we take you from Geiranger and climb to the top of Trollstigen.

The Norwegian fjord landscape constantly tops lists of the world's most beautiful places, and the Geirangerfjord is the queen of these fjords. From Geiranger, you wind your way up Ørnesvingene to the lookout point with a panoramic view of the Geirangerfjord with the "The Seven Sisters" waterfalls, the village and the mountains.

The road continues on through well-maintained agricultural villages, and we take a local ferry across the fjord to Valldal, the strawberry village. There we stop at the wild river rapids at Gudbrandsjuvet before climbing the mountains on our way to the top of Trollstigen. This is an old trail that has miraculously become a road with 11 hairpin bends down the steep mountainside.

A bus will take you from the Havila Voyages ship to the lake where you will paddle. There you will receive safety instructions and all the equipment needed. The glass canoes are stable and make the experience suitable for all levels of ability.

This trip will allow you in an unique way to visit to an area of historical interest. In 1908, a landslide tumbled down the steep mountain sides in Norangsdalen. This landslide blocked the valley and dammed the river. The water flooded a hamlet, and now you can paddle over this settlement and see the walls of the old farmhouses, the road, a bridge and the old gate through the glass bottom of the canoe. The place is popular for divers, and with a glass kayak you get to take part in this unique underwater world.

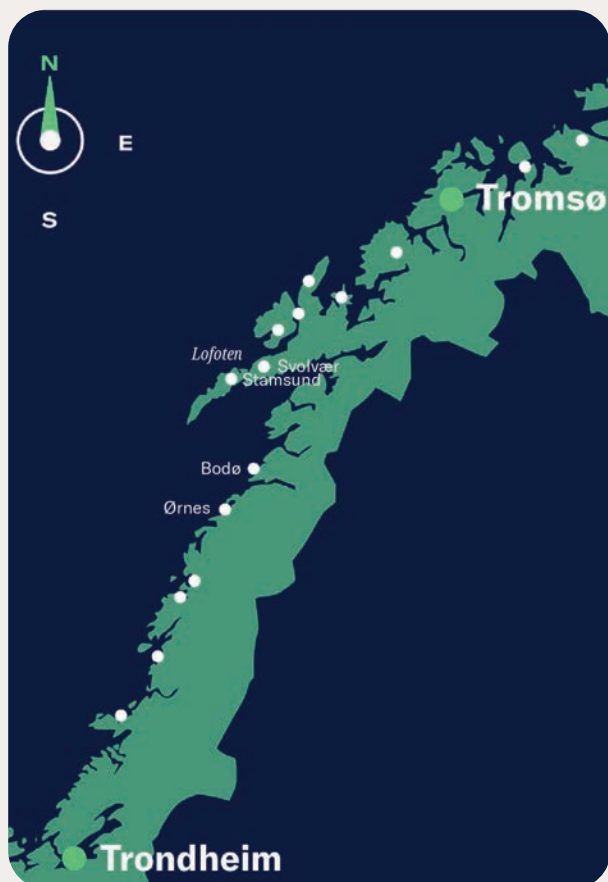

The narrow strait creates the distinctive vortexes, which can reach a diameter of 8 meters. The area has a diverse wildlife, and is a very popular destination for anglers across the world.

Bodø holds the largest population of sea eagles in the world, and you are very likely to encounter one of these majestic birds along your journey.

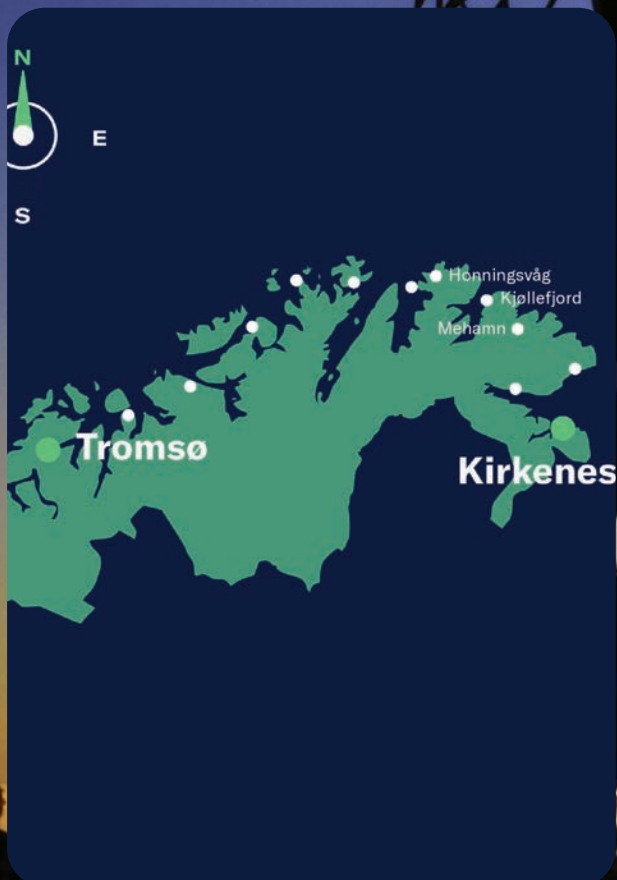

Join a visit to a Sami reindeer herding family with reindeer on summer pasture on the Nordkyn Peninsula, Europe's northernmost mainland. Around the fire in the great lavvo tent, you can hear stories, experience traditions and learn how Sami reindeer herding and traditions have adapted to the modern world. And outside the reindeer graze.

The Sami, the indigenous people living in the northern parts of Norway, Sweden, Finland and Russia. Sami land, which in Sami is called Sápmi, crosses the formal borders between these nations and forms a separate community of peoples.

SNOWHOTEL KIRKENES

Ice cubes in the glass, of course, but when the table, the chairs, the walls, the counter, the candlesticks, the decor and even the fireplace are made of ice, then it really is a snow hotel! Join us for an unforgettable visit to the hotel where everything is made of snow and ice.

As you visit the indoor world of ice, you also get to meet some of the animals that live in the cold polar region. Meet the reindeer which are both draft animals and domestic animals here in the North. Big, wild herds can be found throughout the white expanses and are an important part of Sami life and culture.

After meeting the reindeer, the journey takes us to the ice bar for a cold welcome drink with juice from the wild Arctic crowberry. Next, we visit the huskies, and then a light meal is served on an ice table in a world of ice. You are surrounded by large, beautiful ice sculptures, the walls and windows are made of ice and snow, and while the flower vase might look like it is glass, it is also made of ice.



KING CRAB WITH A SNOWMOBILE ON THE FROZEN FJORD

This is the toughest winter adventure. Snowmobiles and sleds on a frozen fjord and one of the giants of the sea, and get a generous king crab feast after.

KING CRAB FISHING IN A RIB

You get to haul the king crab up from the depths before the RIB takes you back to the quay and the rustic restaurant where you can enjoy a sumptuous meal of white, juicy crab meat.

The giant crab with its long legs can grow two metres in size from pincer to pincer. The king crab is huge and magical with its dark red, spiky shell, under which hides sweet and juicy white crab meat. You can help pull the giant up from the depths and taste this Arctic delicacy.

We set off in our RIB from the king crab town of Kirkenes and head out to the fjord and the sea. There we will pull up the pots that have been on the seabed to catch the king crab. Get involved and help pull up the king crab.

After the catch has been landed, you will be taken by RIB to a rustic restaurant by the fjord where the king crab is served in the classic Norwegian way. Clean, fresh and with a divine taste from the depths of the sea. Portion sizes are on the generous side, so no one should leave the table hungry.

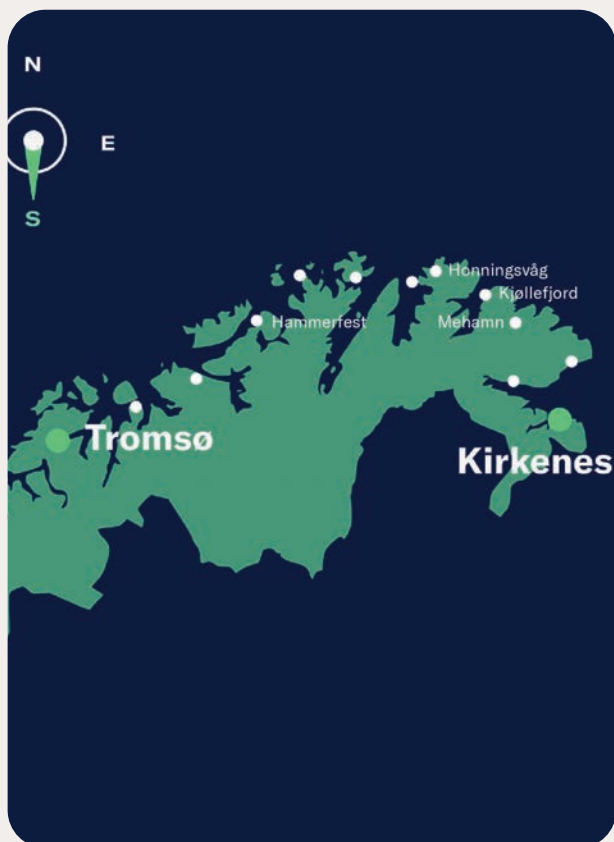

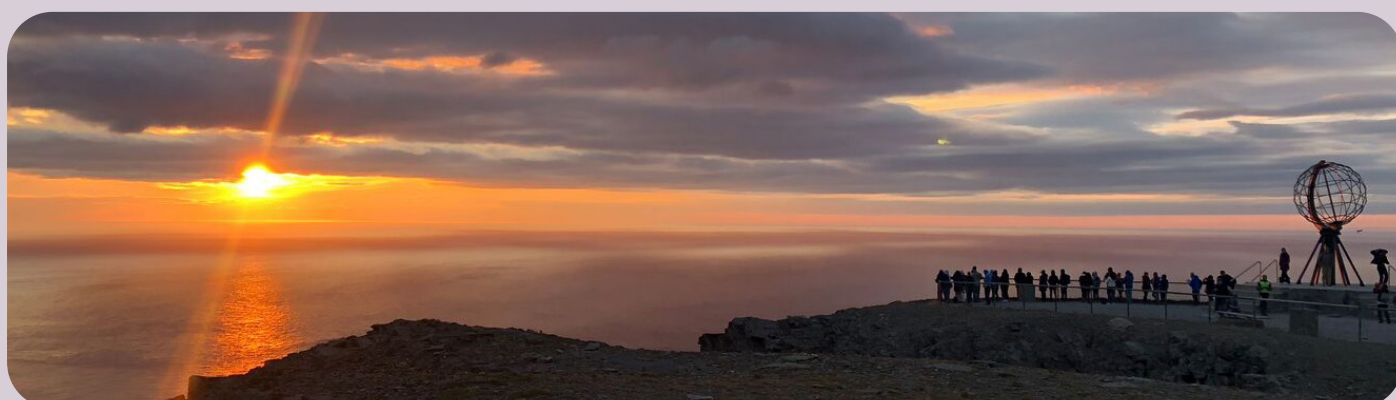

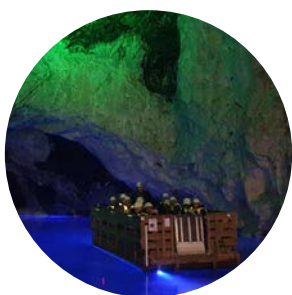
